Hunger Fund Walk at Serenity Farm Sunday, October 20, 2019 at 1:30 pm—The Hunger Fund Walk in Southern Maryland will be hosted at Serenity Farm in Benedict, Maryland. Come raise funds for the hungry while experiencing sweeping waterfront vistas, a walk-in petting zoo and converted historic tobacco barns. Participants will convene at the Harvest House porch before embarking on a 3 mile route. Last year the Hunger Fund Walks raised over \$5,000. 100% of the money was distributed to agencies that supply food to the region's hungry, impoverished children and adults in the form of grants.
